

# How do I schedule recurring investment transactions?

If there is an investment transaction that you enter on a regular basis, memorize it to simplify your work.

Dividend and interest transactions for investment accounts can now be handled as [income reminders](#). For other recurring investment transaction types (such as dollar cost averaging, DRIPs, or other transactions in which there are purchases on a regular basis), set up and manage them using Quicken's [Memorized Investment Transaction List](#).

Although you can't schedule investment transactions on the Financial Calendar, you can memorize them and [create transaction groups](#) to enter multiple transactions at once.
